Art and Architecture in Vallejo

Established in 1851, Vallejo is a wealth of architecturally and historically significant homes, many with panoramic views of waterways. This year's tour will feature six homes; five are historic and one is a newer home in the Heritage designed by two architects. All of the owners are either art collectors or artists, and some are both. This is a unique opportunity to see inside some of the lovely homes of Vallejo and get a glimpse at fascinating private art collections.

While Vallejo has long been a Mecca for the Arts, over the last five years the number of artists moving to Vallejo has grown significantly providing a rich and diverse artistic resource for

The 2006 Art and Architecture Home Tour will also include in its itinerary five galleries on Georgia Street in Historic Downtown Vallejo, three of which have just opened within the last six months. The featured galleries are Evolving Art Gallery, representing contemporary modern art from emerging and established regional and national artists, Ethnic Notions Gallery, fine art gallery with a multicultural emphasis, The W.O.R.K.S, a fine art screen print studio and gallery, and Pacific Rim Gallery, "where art is an adventure," and Procyon Gallery, voted "Best Gallery 2005" by the Times-Herald Readers Poll.
