On October 11th, 2012 at about 10:42 PM. Vallejo Police responded to a 911 call of a Home Invasion Robbery in progress at 106 Cardinal Ln. Vallejo Police and American Canyon Police responded surrounding the house. Three men who were armed with three handguns and a shotgun were taken into custody as they exited the residence. The investigation revealed the subjects entered the occupied residence, held the occupants at gun point, demanded money, jewelry and other items from the occupants while threatening them. The suspects additionally spent several minutes searching the house and the victims while threatening to kill them if they did not cooperate. One of the suspects was in possession of money stolen from the victims when he was taken into custody. The suspects have been identified as;

Kenneth Ray Heinze age 25 of Medford Oregon



Richard Fondren age 20 of Grand Junction Colorado



And James Epperson age 52 of Ashland Oregon



Heinze, Fondren, and Epperson were charged with First Degree Robbery of an Inhabited Dwelling and were booked at the Solano County Jail.
